School Uniform Expectations

As we start the new academic year, we would like to take the opportunity to remind everyone about our school uniform. There are advantages for all – parents/carers, pupils and the school, in the wearing of school uniform. The school has adopted a clear, simple dress code for our pupils which is designed to promote high expectations of the pupils as well as a sense of belonging. **We expect all our pupils to wear the current school uniform.**

Staff encourage children to be smart and presentable in wearing the school uniform and we also ask for parents support in this matter.

For safety, particularly during PE and break times, the only jewellery allowed are watches and studded earrings. Parents are requested to ensure that other items of jewellery are not worn in school.



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Please note when **swimming** the leisure centre do not allow any type of earrings.

We would like to remind you of our current school uniform:

Blue Gorsewood Sweatshirt/Cardigan/Fleece

Grey Trousers/Skirt/Pinafore White Shirt or Polo Style T-Shirt Black, Flat Sensible Footwear

Grey Shorts/Blue & White Gingham Summer Dress - Summer Term

On PE days children should come to school wearing their PE kits:

A Gorsewood PE kit with black pumps or trainers for outdoors

OR Plain white t-shirt, black/blue shorts, black pumps or trainers for outdoor ALSO

In colder weather dark tracksuit/jogging bottoms can be worn with a Gorsewood PE hoodie or Gorsewood sweatshirt/cardigan/fleece.

If a child comes to school wearing a non-uniform top they will be asked to take it off and if cold change into a spare school cardigan/sweatshirt.

Please note football kits, gym wear and other sports items are not PE uniform.

Tuck - Payment Due

We have been fortunate enough again this year to secure some additional funding towards the cost of tuck. We are therefore asking parents/carers for a contribution of **£15.00 per pupil for the full academic year**.

If you would like your child to have daily tuck (fruit), payment needs to be made online via the School Gateway. **The payment option is now live.** Payment can be made in full or termly.

If you do not want your child to have tuck please let the office know and we will remove the charge from your School Gateway account.



Cost of Living

We will always do our best to support all our pupils and families and do what we can to subsidise where possible. All visits will be subsided by school.

Breakfast Club

Breakfast Club runs daily from 7.30am until 8.30am. All children attending receive free breakfast which includes hot chocolate, cereals, bagels and juice. The cost to attend is £1.50 per pupil per day and must be booked online via the School Gateway no later than the day before the session.

Early Bird Drop Off runs daily from 8.30am. There is no charge and children can also access free breakfast. No booking is needed.

Gorsewood After School Club (New Wrap Around Care)

Our new Gorsewood After School Club is now open! This club is supervised by Mrs A Langton and Mrs C Heffernan.

The club runs daily from 3.15pm to 6.00pm Monday to Friday and there are 2 sessions available which include a drink and snack:
