Keeping Children Safe Online - Tips

It is so important that our children stay safe whilst on line. Please come and talk to us if you would like any support in keeping your children safe online.



Agree on Boundaries

Be clear about what your child can and can't do online - where and when they can use the internet, how much time they spend online, the can sites they can visit and the type of information they can share.

Agree with your child when they can have a mobile phone or tablet.

When you do give them their first device make sure that it is set up appropriately for them with the right parental controls in place.

It's a good idea to introduce tech-free meal times and encourage them to keep phones out of the bedroom at night to help them build a healthy screen time balance.

Tuck - Payment Due

We are asking parents/ Tuck payment is now due for this year. carers for a contribution of £15.00 per pupil for the full academic year. This can be paid termly (3 x £5.00) or in full.

Breakfast Club

Breakfast Club runs daily from 7.30am until 8.30am. All children at-tending receive free breakfast which includes hot chocolate, cereals, bagels and juice. The cost to attend is £1.50 per pupil per day and must be booked online via the School Gateway no later than the day before the session.

Early Bird Drop Off runs daily from 8.30am. There is no charge and children can also access free breakfast. No booking is needed.

Gorsewood After School Club (Wrap Around Care)

Our new Gorsewood After School Club is available for all pu**pils.** This club is supervised by Mrs A Langton and Mrs C Heffernan.

The club runs daily from 3.15pm to 6.00pm Monday to Friday and there are 2 sessions available which include a drink and snack:

- Session A = 3.15pm to 5.00pm = £7.00 - Session B = 3.15pm to 6.00pm = £10.00

Places are limited and booking and payment is required upfront on a first come, first served basis via the School Gateway. Only payment upfront will secure and confirm a place.

Following feedback from parents/carers you can now book a place for after school club up to 2.30pm on the same day should you need last minute child care.
