As both the mornings and evenings are now much darker we would like to remind you all to be safe at all times. If you are out and about please remember to wear bright reflective clothing and take extra care on roads and if using scooters or bicycles.

Attendance

Ensuring a child attends school is the legal responsibility of the parent/carer and we aim to work with families to promote good attendance. We aim for all children to be in school every day.

A reminder that all requests for leave of absence in term time must be made in advance in writing by completing a Leave of Absence Form available from the school office.

School will only grant a leave of absence to a pupil during term time if the request meets the specific circumstances set out in the 2024 school attendance regulations. Please note family holidays are not classed as exceptional circumstances and we would expect that parents/carers will arrange their family holidays during the 13 weeks of school holidays so that their children do not miss school.

School is required to inform the Education Welfare Service of any periods of unauthorised absence from school. The EW Service will then consider if the issue of a Penalty Notice is appropriate. Please note Penalty Notices have now changed and there has been an increase to the rate of a penalty notice to ± 80.00 per parent per child if paid within 21 days rising to ± 160.00 per parent per child if unpaid. Keeping Children Safe Online - Tips


Please It is so important that our children stay safe whilst on line. come and talk to us if you would like any support in keeping your children safe online.

Put yourself in control

Set parental controls on your home broadband and any internetenabled devices. Set up a user account for your child on the main device they use and make sure other accounts in the household are password-protected so that younger children can't access them by accident.

Explore together

The best way to support your child online is to talk to them about what they do online and what sites and apps they like to use. Be inquisitive and ask them to show you their favourites to check they're suitable.

Breakfast Club

Breakfast Club runs daily from 7.30am until 8.30am. All children attending receive a free breakfast which includes hot chocolate, cereals, bagels, milkshake and juice. The cost to attend is £1.50 per pupil per day and must be booked online via the School Gateway no later than the day before the session.

Early Bird Drop Off runs daily from 8.30am. There is no charge and children can also access free breakfast. No booking is needed.

Gorsewood After School Club (Wrap Around Care)

Our new Gorsewood After School Club is available for all pu**pils.** This club is supervised by Mrs A Langton and Mrs C Heffernan.

The club runs daily from 3.15pm to 6.00pm Monday to Friday and there are 2 sessions available which include a drink and snack:

- Session A = 3.15pm to 5.00pm = £7.00 - Session B = 3.15 pm to 6.00 pm = £10.00

Places are limited and booking and payment is required upfront on a first come, first served basis via the School Gateway. Only payment upfront will secure and confirm a place.



Following feedback from parents/carers you can now book a place for after school club up to 2.30pm on the same day should you need last minute child care.
